ANSWER KEY

TASK 1

Amphibian- a frog

Reptiles- a snail, crocodile, turtle, snake

TASK 2

We can see a snake, snail, frog etc.

TASK 3

Amphibians need water to lay their eggs. Reptiles lay their eggs on land.

TASK 4

A snake- a reptile. It eats mice or small animals, has no legs or arms, and lives near the water, and it likes hot places during summer.

A crocodile- a reptile. It eats bigger animals like deer or chicken, has short legs and arms with sharp claws, and lives near the water, where it can find food.

A tortoise- a reptile, mostly green or brown, it has a shell on its back and eats mostly vegetables, but also small animals, lives near the water and likes hot weather

A frog- an amphibian. It eats small insects, has longer legs and a bit smaller arms, it can jump very high, make loud noises at night. It lives in the water.

A snail- a very slow animal with a shell on its back. It has no arms but one strong leg that helps it move. It lives in gardens or forests.
