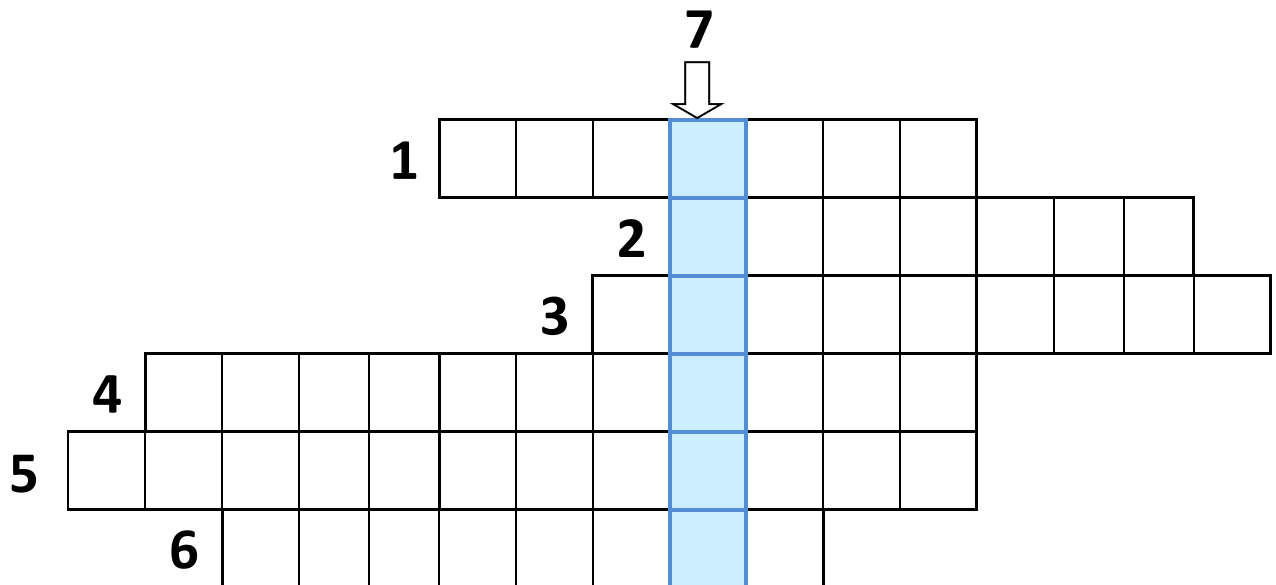


# ACTIVITIES
